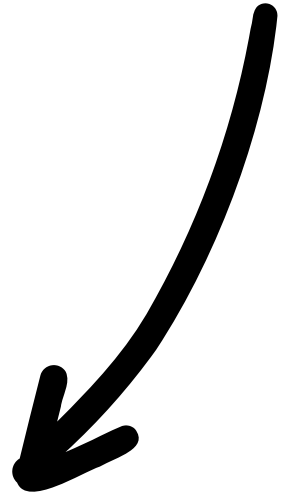
Strength in Every Screw: Building to Last

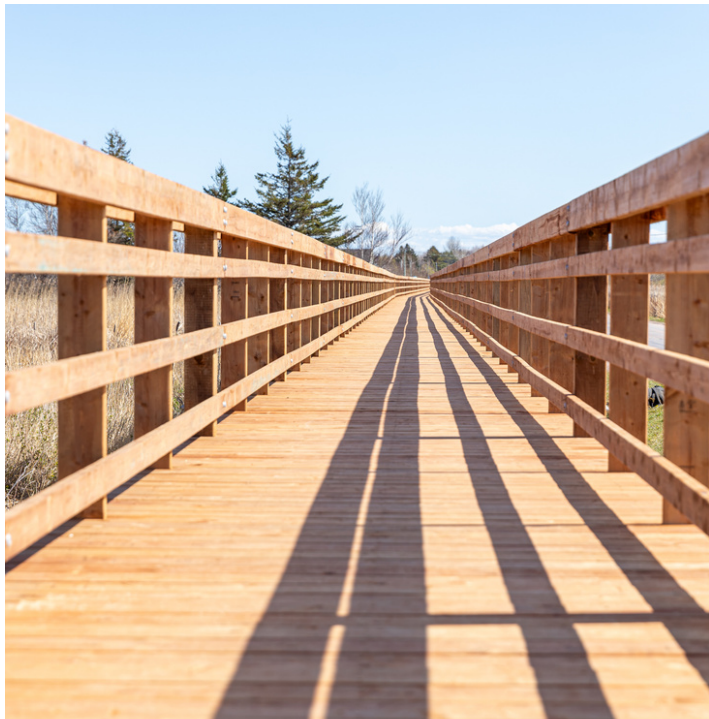
Expanding Access and Enhancing the Experience
